Sub: - Approval Status of the Institution

Dear Sir / Madam,

This is to appraise all the stake holders that approval of the course and the institution imparting the course, by the Pharmacy Council of India at the time of admission of the student to the course and institution is one of the basic pre requisite qualifications for registration in the State Pharmacy Council as per section 12 of Pharmacy Act 1948.

It has been observed that many of the Pharmacists are finding difficulty at the time of registration in securing the letter of the Pharmacy Council of India on the approved status of the institution at the time of their admission.

There are many instances where the candidates apply for registration belatedly many years after they got their Diploma or Degree and find it difficult to get the historical document on the approval status of their institution where they had studied and hence are being deprived of their opportunity to register.

Hence it is suggested and requested to issue approved status document issued by the Pharmacy Council of India to the student either at the time of admission to the institution or at the time of discharge from the institution and make the same a standard procedure.

Further it is also suggested to publish the scanned copy of the historical document in their website to facilitate easy retrieval and the State Council to verify.

The support and co-operation of the Principal's of the Pharmacy Colleges is solicited in this regard in the interest of the profession and the Pharmacist in particular.
