Change of Registered Pharmacist Name

1. General Instructions

- > Registered Pharmacist has to renew and then apply for Change of Name.
- ➤ Use KSPC-E form for Renewal. Click http://kspcdic.com/o renewal
- For Profile updation use KSPC-F form.

2. Eligibility:

- 1. Pharmacist who have registered with Karnataka State Pharmacy Council only can apply.
- 2. Validity of Registration must be upto date.

3. Fees (Refer Notifications on www.kspcdic.com)

4. Scan and keep ready all the following documents:

- a. KSPC Registration Certificate.
- b. 1st Class Judicial Magistrate (Court Order), Gazette Notification, Marriage Certificate & Paper Advertisement authenticating change of name.
- c. Affidavit (not less than 15 working days from the date of Notarization)- On Rs.20/- Non Judicial Bond Paper attested by Notary regarding change in the name.
- **5.** If payment is made by NEFT, the Counter foil of the payment remitted to KSPC account should be uploaded.

Application Form - Print the copy of the auto generated Application Form sent to your mail sign (in BLACK ink only) and send Original KSPC Registration Certificate & Original Affidavit and copy of the Marriage Certificate / Paper Advertisement / Gazette Notification / Court Order along with 15" * 11" size self-addressed (Capital letters only) non-terable cloth lined cover to KSPC office for verification within 7 working days.

Note:

- 1. Original Certificates submitted by the pharmacist will be returned along with the new Certificate issued by the Council.
- 2. Retention of Name in the register Renew every year before 31st of March as per Sec.34 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
- 3. The council is nowhere responsible for any wrong information provided by the pharmacist and deviations from the original certificates. Please ensure proper filling of the application before submission.
